

CONCEALABLE SIZING

Instructions

To ensure the proper fit, be precise and record all the requested measurements on the Concealable Sizing Form. During sizing, the officer should wear their on-duty undergarment, duty pants and duty belt. The officer should not artificially adjust the height of their duty belt. The officer should not sit or stand artificially erect.

A separate person should conduct the measuring using a vinyl or cloth measuring tape. Ensure the tape remains leveled and snug; do not over tighten.

NECESSARY TOOLS:

Sizing Form and Chart. Writing Utensil. Armless Chair. Soft Tape Measure



Chest Measurement

- 1. Measure <u>around</u> the widest part of the chest
- 2. Round your measure up to the nearest whole number



Waist Measurement

- Measure <u>around</u> the widest part of the waist closest to the belly button
- 2. Round your measure up to the nearest whole number




Front Measurement (While Seated)

- Measure the top of the clavicle to 1" above the duty belt
- 2. Round your measure up to the nearest whole number



Front Measurement (While Seated)

- 1. Measure the center of the sternum to 1" above the duty belt
- 2. Round your measure up to the nearest whole number



Back Measurement

- Measure from the top of the shoulder blades to 1" above the duty belt while standing
- 2. Round your measure up to the nearest whole number
